

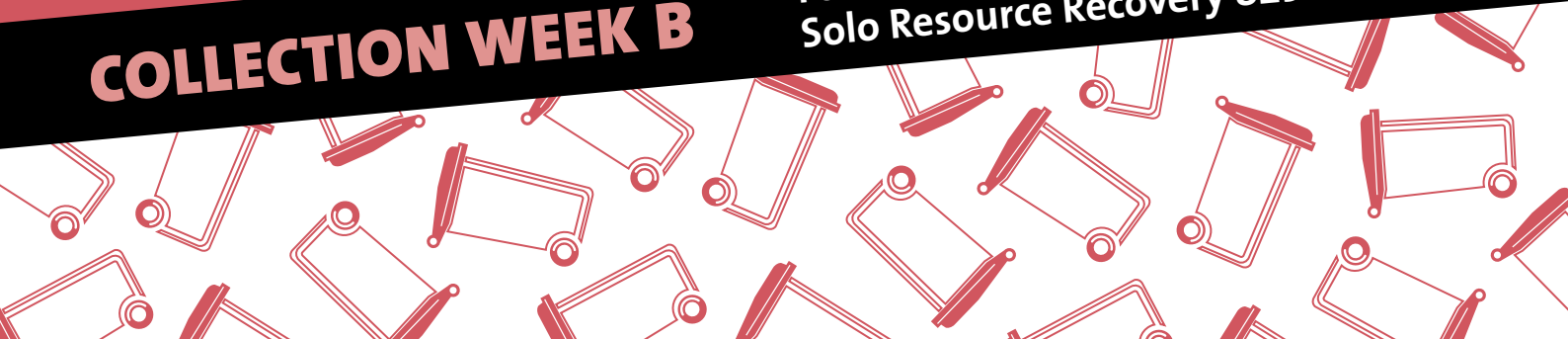

Collection Day

Step 1

Use the calendar key to determine your organics collection week and your recycling collection week.

Your waste to landfill (blue lid) bin is collected every week. Place your bins out by 6am.

■ Organics bin week (green lid).
Bins out by 6am.

■ Recycling bin week (yellow lid).
Bins out by 6am.

■ No collection Good Friday, Christmas Day or New Year's Day.
All collections that week will take place the next day.

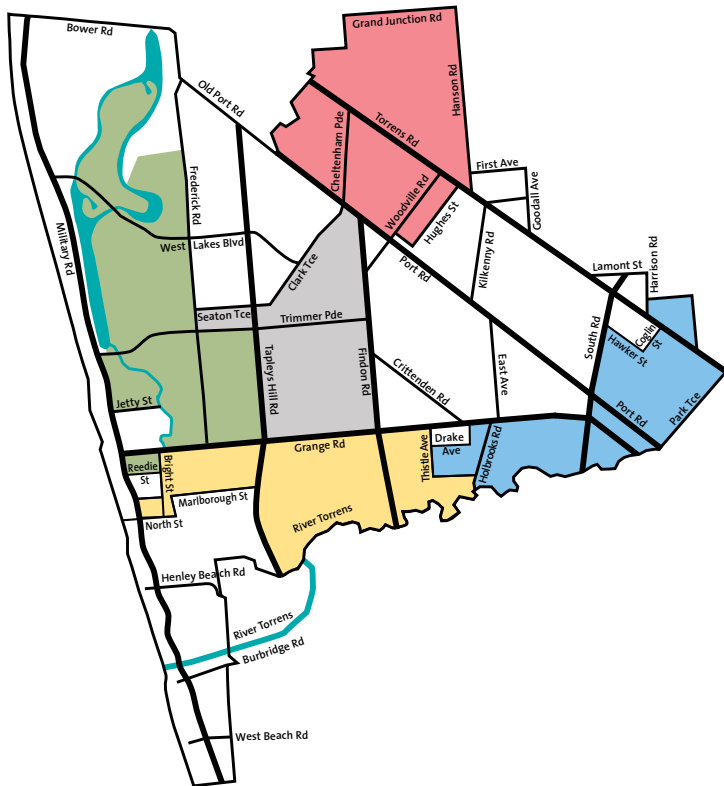


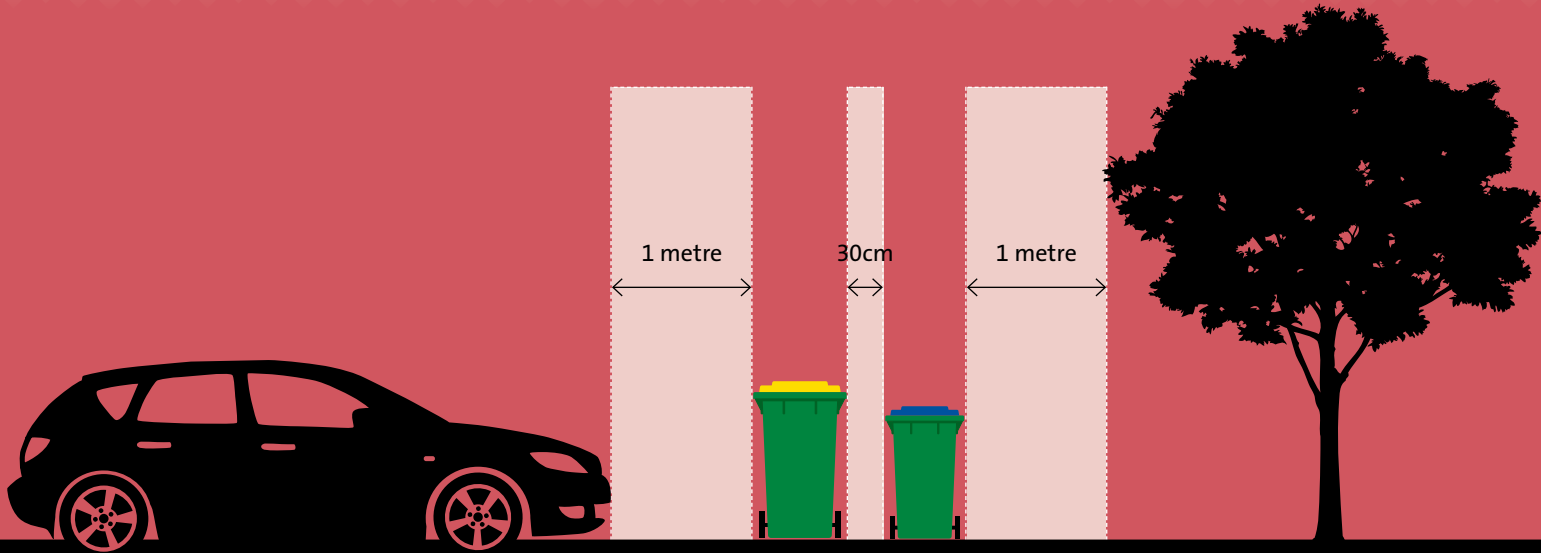
A handy reference

Correct bin placement

Keep a minimum distance of 30cm between bins, and 1 metre between bins and parked cars, street trees, stobie poles and letter boxes wherever possible

Bin placement

To ensure your bins are emptied on your scheduled collection day, you need to:

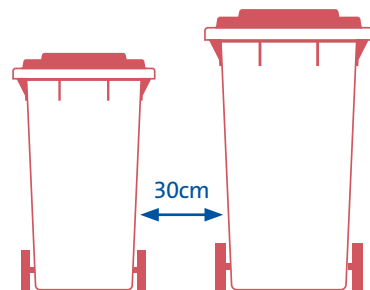
- Put bins out by **6.00am** on day of collection and bring them back in within 24 hours of collection
- Face each bin in the right direction - wheels towards the house
- Keep a minimum of 30cm clear around each bin
- Don't overfill your bin (max. weight 75kg) and make sure the bin lid is closed (otherwise your bins may not be collected)

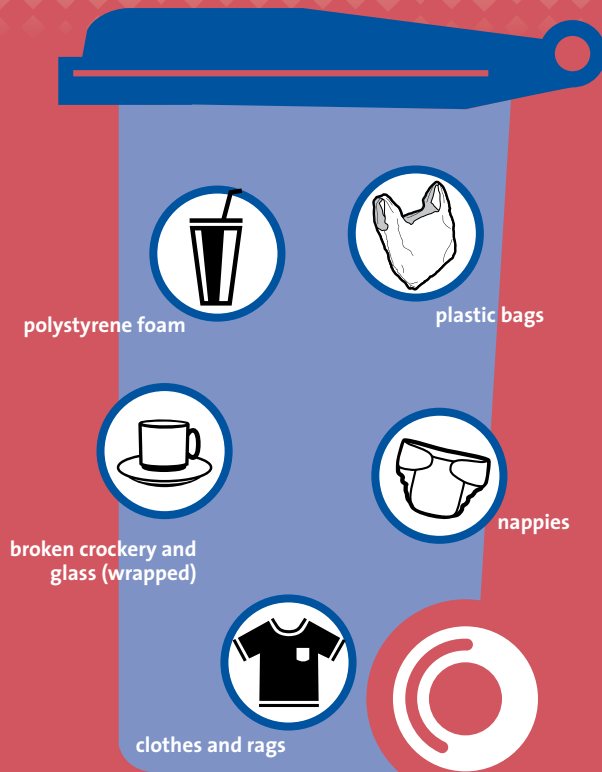

Waste to landfill

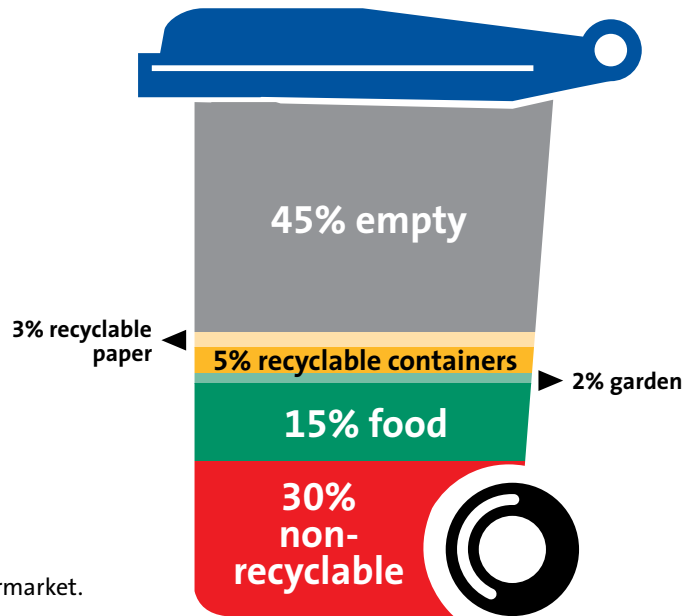
Your waste (blue lid) bin is collected weekly. Everything in this bin will be sent to landfill.

What goes in the waste to landfill bin?

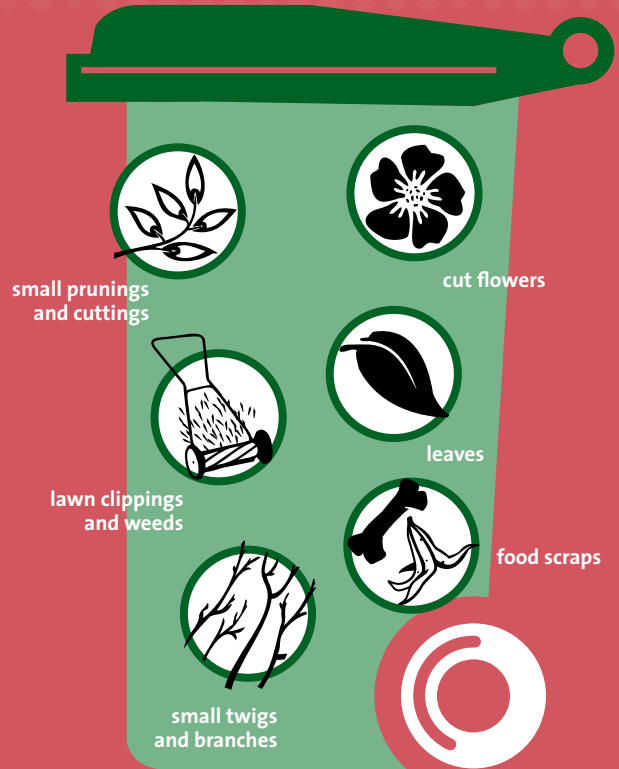
Household waste that cannot be placed in the green organics or yellow recycling bin, including:

- Soft plastics & food packaging (plastic bags, chip packets, cling film)
- Nappies
- Kitty litter (wrapped)
- Small broken items such as china and glass ware
- Wine and water bladders
- Clothing and rags that are not suitable for donating to charity
- Polystyrene foam (including cups, meat trays and packaging)
- Ropes and hoses

Tip: Most soft plastics can be recycled by taking them into any major supermarket. To find a location near you visit www.redcycle.net.au



WHAT CAN I PUT IN MY ORGANICS (GREEN LID) BIN?



Organics for compost

ALL FOOD SCRAPS are good to go - place them in your green organics bin.

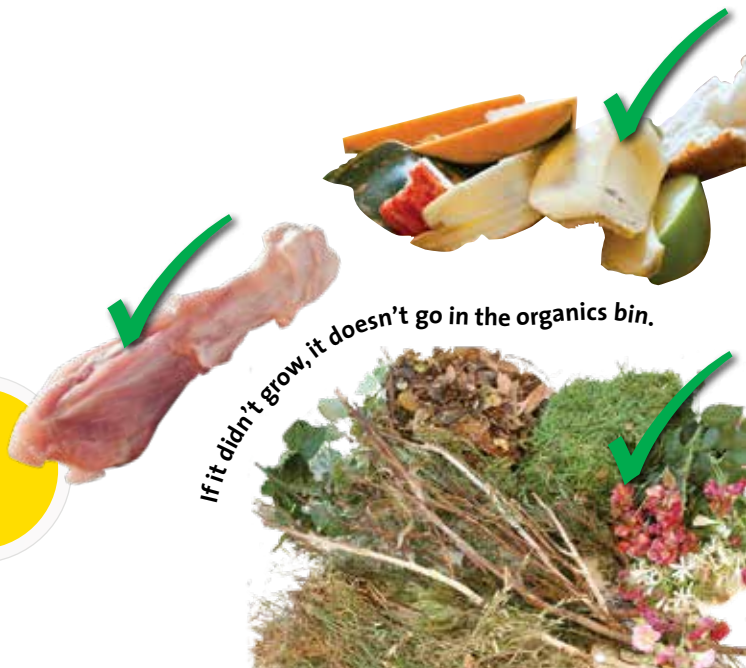
Your organics (green lid) bin is collected fortnightly.

Refer to the collection calendar on page 1.

What goes in the organics bin?

- Garden prunings, cuttings and branches (max diameter of 10cm)
- Lawn clippings, weeds and leaves
- All food waste including fruit and vegetable scraps, meat scraps, bones and seafood, egg shells, pizza boxes, shredded paper, tissues and paper towel, dairy products

Have you got your kitchen caddy yet?
If not, call in at the Council offices to pick up your free caddy and a roll of compostable bags.



WHAT CAN I PUT IN MY RECYCLING (YELLOW LID) BIN?



Recycling right

**Your recycling (yellow lid) bin is collected fortnightly.
Refer to the waste calendar on page 1.**

What goes in the recycling (yellow lid) bin?

- Paper and cardboard (newspapers, magazines, junk mail, envelopes, egg cartons, cardboard boxes - flattened)
- Liquid paperboard cartons (eg juice & milk cartons - rinsed)
- Glass bottles and jars (rinsed, lids off)
- Aluminium and steel cans
- All rigid plastic containers (eg plastic drink bottles, detergent bottles, yoghurt, icecream and margarine containers)
- Empty paint tins with lids removed

Recycling tips

- Remove all lids
- Place items loose into your recycling bin
- Shredded paper can be placed in a paper bag or envelope
- Plastic lids can be placed in a larger plastic bottle and when the bottle is full, cap it and place in the bin



Book your hard waste pick-up

- Each household can book up to **2 FREE collections** per financial year.
- Max. of 2m^3 (2m x 1m x 1m) of waste per collection.
- Excess or unacceptable material will not be collected.

Waste that is placed on the kerbside at any other time is illegal dumping and will incur a \$1000 fine.



What is Hard waste?

Please ensure waste does not block the footpath or road.

Place waste out the night before your booked collection.

The hard waste service is a residential service only. No commercial or business properties.

- Furniture and bedding
- Small electrical items
eg. radios, fans, hand driers etc.
- Tools and gardening equipment
- White goods – fridge/freezers, washing machines, stoves and dryers (with lids and doors removed)
- Scrap metal and timber items (up to 2m in length)
- Empty paint tins
- Kitchenware – pottery and crockery
- No TV's or computers
- No items heavier than 50kg or longer than 2 metres
- No oils or liquid waste – including paint cans with residual liquids in them
- No vehicle bodies or parts, including engines, body panels, tyres and batteries
- No building materials (including bricks, concrete, plasterboard, dirt or rocks).
- No chemical or hazardous waste
- No gas bottles or asbestos
- No business waste
- No ceramics eg. toilets, basins etc.
- No items in plastic bags, including domestic waste
