

Frank Mitchell Park / Woodville West Reserve Master Plan – Stage 2 Notice of construction

In 2007/08 Council endorsed a Master Plan to upgrade both Frank Mitchell Park and Woodville West Reserve.

Stage 1 of the upgrade was completed in 2008/09 and involved significant work on a large part of Frank Mitchell Park. This included the removal of the perimeter mounds, installation of a new irrigation system and the relocation of all soccer ancillary facilities. The benefits of this work have seen a larger training area created for the resident soccer club and equally, the playing fields are now open and accessible to the wider community when not being used for 'structured' Soccer Club activities.

Council has recently endorsed Stage 2 of the project, with the focus now being on rejuvenating Woodville West Reserve. The construction works will include the following:

- An additional junior soccer field
- Installation of a new irrigation system
- New play equipment (this includes removal of the existing play equipment)
- New shelters, BBQ and furniture
- An 'off-street' car park and pathways
- Installation of bollards and fencing
- Tree and shrub planting

It is envisaged that the work will commence in late August 2009 with the project due for completion by January 2010.
