- This is an ongoing promotion, starting in April 2019.
- To enter, upload a video (30 seconds maximum) of your pet completing The Mission, within the comments on the original Mission Post on the Pets of Charles Sturt Facebook page or use the #POCSMI hashtag on Instagram.
- Entries via Instagram must be from public accounts, private accounts are not eligible.
- Entrants may submit one video per pet over the course of each month.
- Each entry is only valid for that month. Videos used previously are not eligible to win in later months.
- A winner will be selected from entries received up until 12 noon (Adelaide time) on the last Friday of every month.
- The winner is chosen on the following criteria:
 - Pet is engaged and focused on owner
 - Pet completes the mission successfully
- The winning video may be shared on the Pets of Charles Sturt Facebook page or the [City of Charles Sturt's Instagram account \(@charlessturtsa\)](#).
- City of Charles Sturt will endeavour to contact the winners, however it is up to the winners to respond to arrange collection of the prize.

- Entries of dogs and cats must be currently registered on DACO (www.dogsandcatsonline.com.au)
- Entries that the City of Charles Sturt considers inappropriate (e.g. offensive, defamatory, aggressive etc.) will not be eligible for the competition and may be reported or removed possible.
- Where dogs are filmed in harnesses, leads or collars, the equipment must be humane as recommended by the RSPCA SA Lead By Example Campaign (entries of dogs wearing choke chains and prong collars are not permitted. Electric collars are illegal in South Australia).
- Entries that show physical or verbal punishment will not be included. Charles Sturt follows the training method recommendations of the RSPCA SA (<https://www.rspcasa.org.au/the-issues/lead-by-example/>).
