

VISITING HENLEY & GRANGE COMMUNITY CENTRE





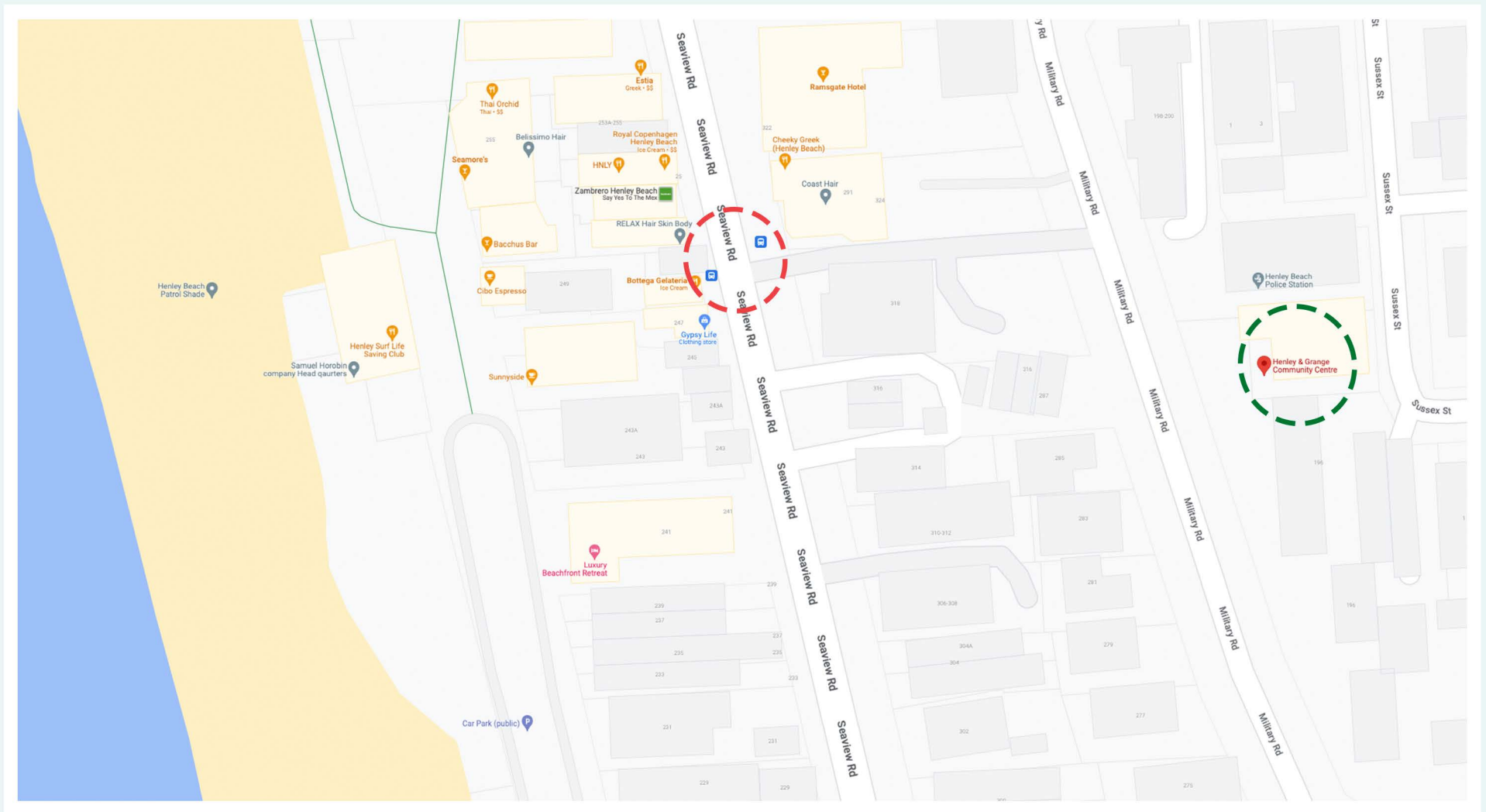
A community centre is a place where residents can meet for events, programs and recreational activities.

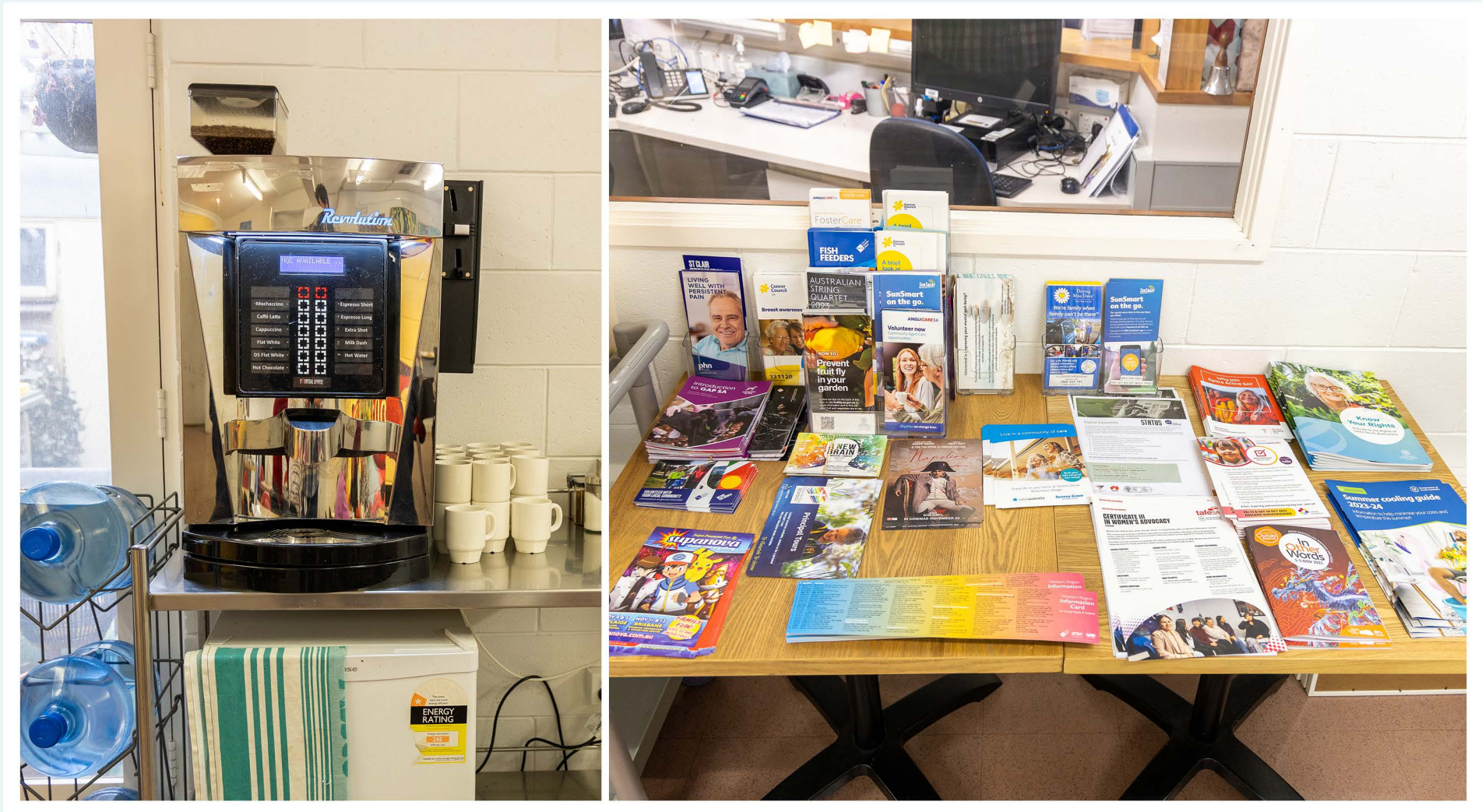
How can we help you communicate?

How to use this communication board

Offer this communication board to someone if they appear to have a communication difficulty. If they wish to use it, use this side of the board first to identify how they communicate and what you can do to help. Check to make sure you have understood before moving on. Next, turn over the board and ask what you can help with. If the person is unsure, point to options and read them out. You can encourage the person to point to the yes/no at the top of the board or use another method that works for them. The messages highlighted in green are staff messages that you could say to the resident. Always remember to check with the person to make sure you have understood them and always ask "is there anything else?".

There are communication tools available too.
