



Local Nuisance – Exemption

Conditions of Application:

- 1. **Council notification:** For an application in relation to an activity that is to take place over a period not exceeding 24 hours
 - At least 2 weeks before the activity commences; or
 - As requested by Council.

For an application in relation to an activity that is to take place over a period of 24 hours or longer -

- At least 4 weeks before the activity commences; or
- As requested by Council.
- 2. If an application for a declaration in relation to an activity is not lodged with council as required above or does not include the relevant supporting documentation, the council may refuse to consider the application.
- 3. If Council believes the activity is not considered to be exceptional circumstances, the application may be refused.
- 4. If an activity requires an exemption and is carried out without this declaration, then penalties may apply under the Local Nuisance and Litter Control Act 2016 as determined by the Council. The person responsible or the exemption holders are liable to any action under this Act.
- 5. Approvals may be required outside of this form for an activity you may wish to be exempt from (ie road closure or development approval or event approval).
- 6. Council may request further information before approving this request. This may include an acoustic engineer's assessment from activities which may generate excessive noise.
